<b>Dundas Historical Society Museum - <i>Community family festivals</i></b> Five different events that celebrate the history of Dundas. It is anticipated that 1,000 families and youth will be engaged.	\$5,000
<b>Dundas Valley Orchestra - <i>Spotlight on Dundas</i></b> A free concert highlighting Dundas musicians, performers and composers during Arts Dundas weekend. Parts of the concert will also be performed at several seniors' centres in Dundas.	5,700
<b>Dundas Valley School of Art - <i>Family ART days</i></b> Free hands-on visual art workshops to families in the Dundas community.	16,500
<b>Dundas Youth Chaplaincy - <i>Routes Youth Centre</i></b> General operating funds. Services include drop-ins, recreational activities, snacks, homework labs, and educational workshops.	10,000
<b>Green Venture - <i>RAIN home visits</i></b> SPONSORSHIP BY CONSERVER SOCIETY To provide visits with Dundas residents to educate them on how to protect their homes from flooding. RAIN home visits have proven to assist homeowners in prioritizing actions to eliminate the incidence impact of stormwater runoff infiltrating the home and/or reaching the storm sewer.	8,213
<b>Hamilton Philharmonic Orchestra (2000) Inc. - <i>Dundas senior and student programming</i></b> To provide a series of educational and performance activities focusing on youth and seniors in the Dundas area.	10,500
<b>Rotary Club of Hamilton - <i>Telling Tales</i></b> Festival to support and promote literacy at Westfield Heritage Village.	1,500
<b>Skills for Change of Metro Toronto - <i>Bridging the Gap</i></b> Creation of conversational circles for seniors and youth with a focus on technology and the arts. Partnerships have been established with four Dundas based organizations.	20,077
<b>The Salvation Army Hamilton Community &amp; Family Services - <i>Community services food bank</i></b> Basic need items for the food bank.	10,000
<b>Urquhart Butterfly Garden - <i>Summer educational programme</i></b> SPONSORSHIP BY CONSERVER SOCIETY Workshops being offered in the garden during the summer months.	2,800
